The Kuwaiti Financial Support for the Countries of Arab East from 1961-1981

Abstract:

The exploration of oil in Kuwait in 1946 is considered to be as a numerous turning point in its economic and political history. Since 1961, Kuwait has been interested in giving support to achieve Arab benefits. Kuwait has seen the support it gives for the sake of Arab benefits as a national duty. An example of this was the role that Kuwait Monetary Fund for Economic Growth played for supporting a variety of projects of some countries of the Arab East. Equally significant, Kuwait had important role in the forming of Arab conferences, which have started since 1964 and were interested in showing the support for the Arab-Israeli conflicts, which were held by Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, and Palestine. Kuwait also allocated its funds for being a mediator in the Arab-Israeli conflicts, and for maintaining the Arab unity in general and the Arab Gulf unity in particular. Moreover, Kuwait played a significant role in establishing the Arab Gulf Council in 1981.
